Dear Pat,

Just a brief note to let you know the results of my most recent examination of the circle material from Butleigh Wooton, Sumerset, England. The material reached my lab. in fairly decent shape and I was able to obtain good micro-sections of fresh tissue.

- 1) There were no apparent differences in the plant cell structures between the control and circle samples.
- 2) Nothing definate was spotted in terms of external damage to the plants.
- 3) Both soil samples appeared to have the same coloration.

An attempt was made to grow the plants in sterile soil. Apparently the trauma of shipment was too great — both plants are now dead. If they had been slightly further along in development I think they would have made it.

Hope you are successful in finding more circles and material for study.
